

## **2). WATER TANKS INSTALLATION TO SCHOOLS PROJECT**

Following water tank needs assessment report for less privileged schools done by the child protection program, LINDA foundation graced the program by donating Ksh. 698,510 for the purchase of 5pieces (10,000litres each) capacity water tanks, installation of gutters and construction of water tank bases for 4 schools.

The beneficiary schools included:-

1. Majiwa primary school – 2 tanks
2. Keyo kodindo primary school – 1 tank
3. Abom primary school – 1 tank
4. Kitambo primary school – 1 tank

### **0.3 ACHIEVEMENTS**

1. Despite the slow change of attitude and behaviors in the communities that have for a long time believed in the virtues of their traditions and practicing of humiliating punishments to children, there's is increased awareness creation and advocacy on children rights, responsibilities and protection.
2. Successful implementation of reusable sanitary towels project to vulnerable girls made substantial contributions by strengthening the individual commitments of the 400 girls to the fight against children sexual abuse hence change of mind set to focus on education.
3. Trained child protection agents in schools, homes, villages and likeminded organizations are actively inspired in facilitating various trainings of child protection

methodology in their individual capacities thus resulting in improved management of empowerment on child rights and protection.

4. Child protection program adds to the list of known organizations across Bondo Sub County in support of education sector after a successful implantation of water tanks project to 4 schools. This has equally improved health and hygiene of children while at school.
5. Increased good relationship between the child protection program and other stakeholders is impressive hence easy roll out of child protection activities.
6. Reduced level of child abuse cases and school drop out cases.
